In 1997, the City of Asheville acquired title to the Grove Arcade building under the National Monument Act. The Grove Arcade Public Market Foundation was established to oversee the renovation of the building, returning it to a public retail center after more than forty years as a federal building. In 1999, the Vetust Study Club Inc. contributed \$10,000 towards this goal. The proceeds from the 2009 and 2010 Antiques Fair have been pledged to the continued restoration of this historic building.
